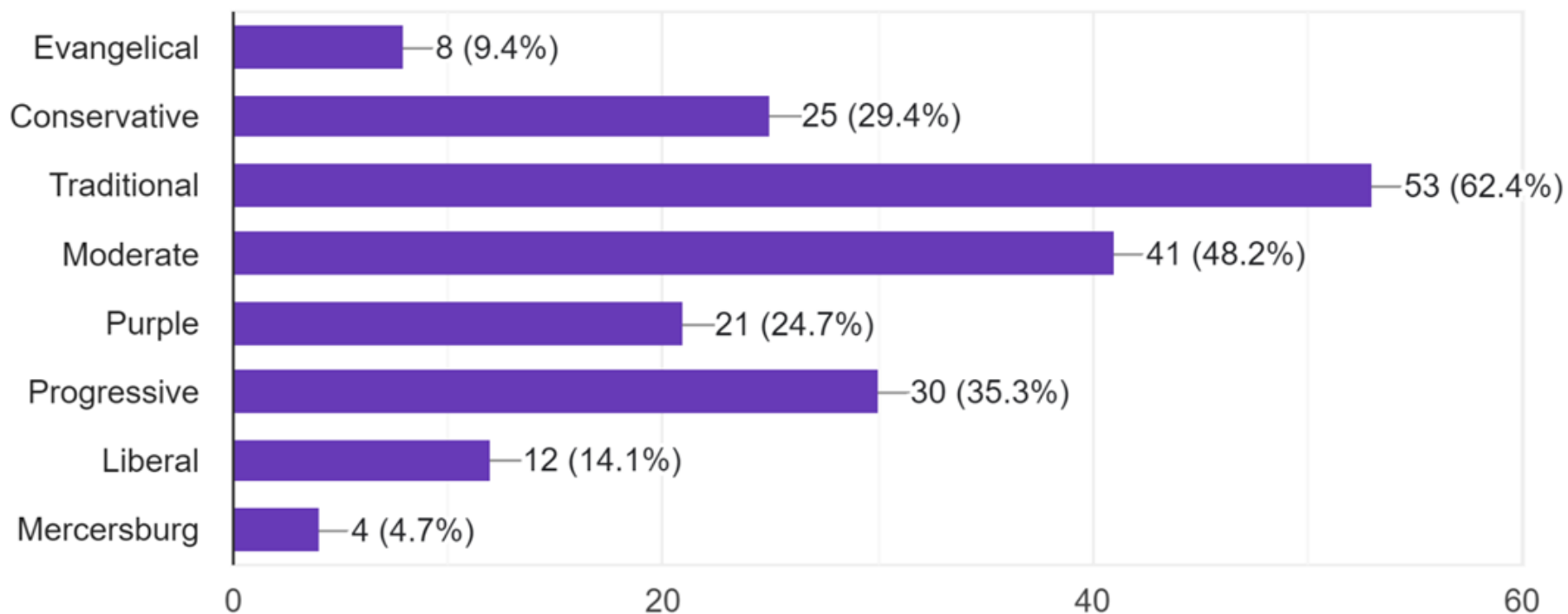


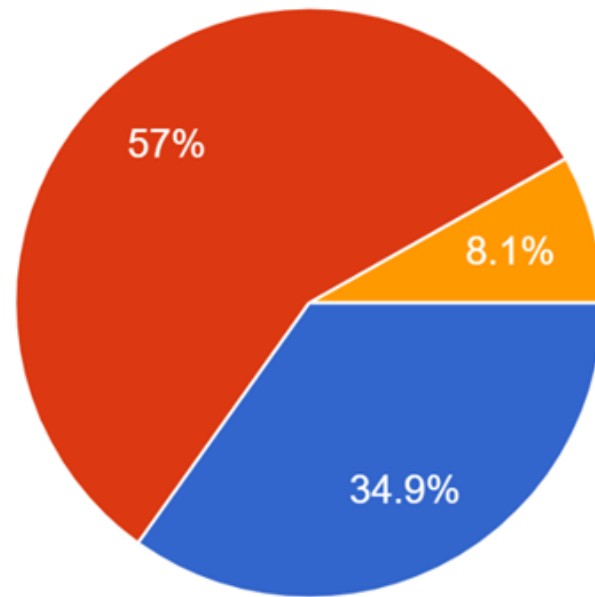
How would you describe your congregation's theological orientation? (Click any that apply.)

(e.g. anti-racist, open & affirming, etc.)

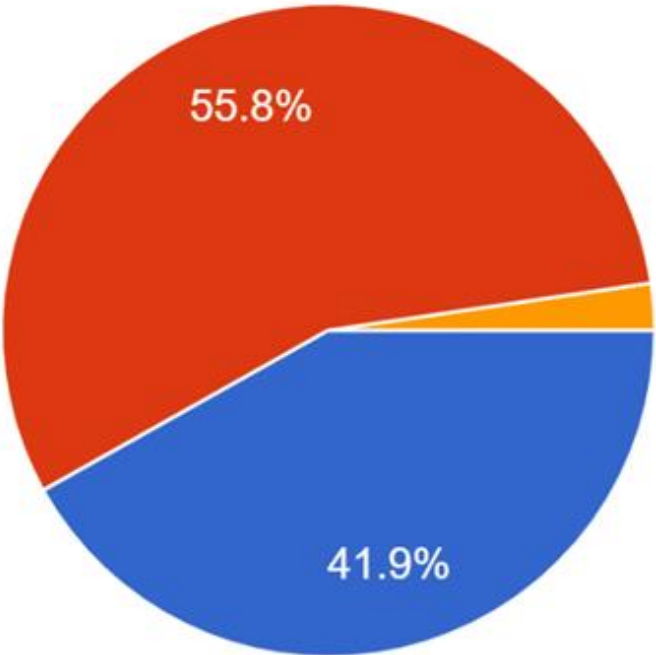

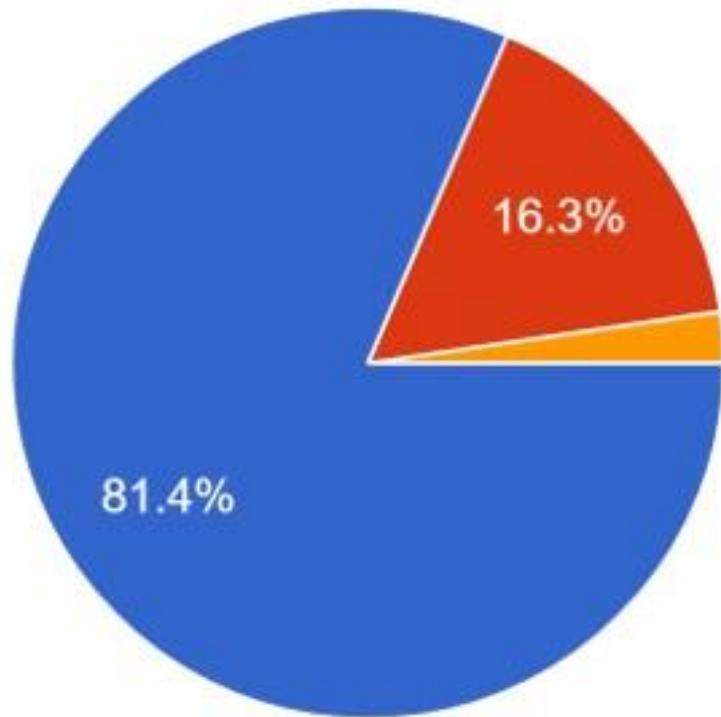
- 1 - Our church is proudly UCC
